Now Enrolling: Biometric Study for Typically-Developing Individuals

A study to collect biosensor data in individuals without autism to advance autism research

We're currently enrolling typically developing teens and adults ages 13 to 35 for a study that collects biosensor data in individuals without autism.

This study uses a device to collect biometric data through electroencephalogram (EEG), electrocardiogram (ECG), eye tracking, facial expression analysis software, and potentially an ActiGraph watch. In this clinical study, individuals without autism will help our team gather data that will be used as a comparison for similar data collected in current and future autism studies.



STUDY PARTICIPATION WILL INVOLVE:

Cohort 1:

- 1 in-person study visit
- \$100 in compensation for time and travel

Cohort 2:

- Attend 2 visits 6 weeks apart
- \$100 in compensation for time and travel for each visit and an extra \$100 for completing study activities between visits

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE:

- Ages 13-35 (both males and females)
- Individual does not have an autism diagnosis
