Learn more about a research study of an investigational medication for teens and adults who have been diagnosed with **autism spectrum disorder (ASD)**.

The purpose of this study is to see if an investigational medication is safe and effective for individuals with autism.

To be eligible for this study, participants must:

- Be 13 to 35 years of age
- Have been diagnosed with autism
- Live with a caregiver or spend time with a caregiver on a regular basis

Additional eligibility criteria will apply.

Participants and their caregivers will attend 7-8 visits over 14-18 weeks. Participants will be closely monitored through health exams, tests, and caregiver reports.

Qualified participants may receive all study-required medication and medical care at no cost. A stipend may be provided to help cover study-required travel costs.
